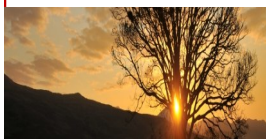
That baptism by immersion is the door into the church, an outward symbol of surrender to Christ. (Acts 2:38)

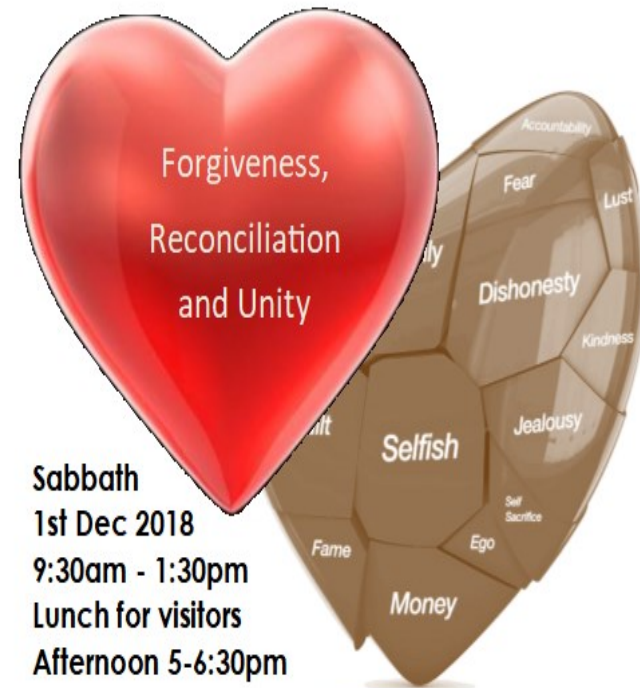
